

Thailand Student Assistance Status

John Middlewood was the founder and driving force behind the student assistance program in Nakhon Phanom. His passing left the program in serious jeopardy. Ed Miller stepped up and was able to run the student assistance program through March 2015. The Assistance Committee, after much deliberation, then made the decision that if it could not find someone to take over the program by the end of March, it would have to discontinue the program.

Fortunately as you will read below, things are now finally in place to continue the program.

In February 2015, John Sweet, Roger Durant and Les Thompson made a trip to Thailand. It was originally planned as a trip to say farewell to John Middlewood, but his condition deteriorated much quicker than anticipated and sadly, we missed being able to see him one last time.

While visiting John's widow Maeo to offer our condolences and to meet with some of the students and their teachers, we were introduced to Satawat Sri-in. Khun Satawat is a long time member of John's church, had helped John with the student assistance program and is fluent in English. We talked with Khun Satawat about him taking over the running of the student assistance program in Nakhon Phanom, he said he would consider it and let us know.

In March, Khun Satawat contacted the assistance committee and said he would be willing to do the job. The process of getting him signed up with the TLCB and getting everything in place that he needed to handle the student assistance program was started. It has taken almost 3 months to get everything in place.

During this process and in view of what was experienced with John's sudden passing and the aging of everyone involved, the committee felt it best to start a sunset plan for the student assistance program. What was decided was that the program would continue with only the students eligible in March of 2015. As long as they stay in school and eligible for assistance, we will continue to assist them through university. Given the youngest students, this means the program will continue for 8 to 9 more years. During this time, the committee will continue to look at alternative approaches to this very successful program.

I want to extend my appreciation to Ed Miller for his hard work in picking up the pieces and keeping things on track through March. My sincerest thanks to every member of the committee for their dedication and insightful suggestions during this time of change. Finally, a warm welcome and thanks to our newest member of the assistance program, Khun Satawat Sri-in.
