Motion 16-13 Laos Quality of Life Program

Estimated Amount = \$3,775.00

Proposed: That the TLCB approve a grant to the Ban Hai Primary School, Muang Kham District, Xieng Khouang Province for \$3,775 for replacement roofing tin and a two-room toilet.

Background: The XK Provincial Education Service and Sports has submitted the following request:

“The Ban Hai Primary School is 73 km east of Phonsavanh town on the Xieng Khouang - Vietnam road, Route 7.

It has two classroom buildings each sized 8 x 26 m (including the corridor) of semi-permanent construction built in 1994. The school is old and dilapidated due to having been dismantled at its former location and re-erected at Ban Hai. There are seven teachers, six are women, one man, with 146 students of whom 66 are girls. Of those, 12 are Hmong including five girls.

The main problems at the school are that there is no toilet and the old roofing tin is rusted out. The school has never been assisted by any agency or the Government to help maintain it. The community has been unsuccessful in obtaining funding for necessary repair and upgrading.

Thus the school has submitted a proposal to the Kham District DESS to request assistance from the Province PESS to request help from the TLCB to build a two-place toilet and re-roof the two classroom buildings.

Thus the PESS is submitting this request to the TLCB for consideration in providing tin and materials to build a school toilet.“

Recommendation: That this request for \$3,775 be approved.

Motion 16-16 Laos Quality of Life Program

Estimated Amount = \$2,290.00

Proposed: That the TLCB authorize \$2,290 to fund roofing tin for the Ban Hai Hin Primary School, Paek District, Xieng Khouang Province.

Background: The Xieng Khouang Provincial Education Service and Sports provides the following information:

“Ban Hai Hin Primary School is a complete Primary School of Grades 1 through 5 located some 10 km from Phonsavan town on the road to the Plain of Jars. This school has had problems in the past because the community is made up of villagers of different ethnic groups who were moved from various locations to establish a village there. This led to an initial lack of collaboration and a lack of leadership and funding to maintain and care for the school.

“For these reasons, the school and the Village Headman have asked the PESS to request assistance from the TLCB for tin to re-roof one of the school’s classroom buildings which measures 46 x 8 m, including the corridor. The present roof is rusted out. Many of the villagers do not have the means to contribute funding as they do not have land for making a living.

“The school has three buildings, two of which are of permanent construction and one building of semi-permanent construction build in 1992. There are 13 teachers of whom 10 are women. One teacher is of Hmong ethnicity. There are 297 students of whom 153 are girls. There are 83 Lao Loum students of whom 38 are girls, 214 Hmong students of whom 115 are girls.”

Recommendation: That the requested \$2,290 be approved.

Motion 16-17 Laos Quality of Life Program

Proposed: That the TLCB fund \$5,600 for roofing materials and cement for three buildings at the Lat Khai Secondary School, Phaxay District, Xieng Khouang Province.

Background: The Xieng Khouang Provincial Education Service and Sports (XK PESS) provides the following information:

“The Lat Khai Secondary School is located within the boundary of Phaxay District town, lies some 30 Km. from Phonsavan town and serves some 18 villages of the District. The school was built in 1996 and consists of two buildings of permanent construction, and four buildings of semi-permanent construction. There are 66 teachers of whom 35 are women. Five teachers are Hmong. There are 814 students of whom 374 are women, and 536 of the 814 are Lao Loum. 275 are Hmong of whom 117 are women, three are Khamou. Most of the students come from more remote villages.

“This school has received little outside assistance to construct school buildings as by and large, the villagers have cut and used lumber from the surrounding area, and bought tin for roofing. At present the semi-permanent buildings are old and worn with leaking roofs. The school has one library building of unfinished construction which still has no roof or floor. The community has tried to raise sufficient funds for these repairs but has been unable to do so. The people face many problems and a lack of funds.

“Thus the school and community request assistance from the TLCB to buy tin to re-roof two school buildings and tin and cement to finish the roof and lay the floor of the library.

“The size of these buildings including corridors is:

1. Building #1: 52 x 8 m.
2. Building #2: 30 x 8 m.
3. Library: 20 x 8 m.”

Recommendation: That the requested funding of \$5,600 be approved.
