Motion 17-03 Laos Quality of Life Program

Estimated Amount = \$3,450

Actual Amount = \$3,450.00

Proposed: That TLCB approve funding for a new school floor for the Khamsavang school in the Songkhone Savannakhet School District.

We are expanding from our normal area of operations to the south near Savannakhet in an entirely new area of operations. We've done a survey of the village and school needs back in September and the local officials have requested we assist with a concrete floor at one of the primary schools as well as walls and flooring at a second school. Since this is our first foray into the area, I want to start small and see how it goes before future possible expansion to the other schools.

The dimensions of the school are typical of Laos and the funds will cover cement, rock and sand. Labor will be provided by parents of the students as well as my team. I've attached pictures of the school for reference.

Recommendation: That TLCB approve this request for \$2,100

Proposed: That TLCB approve funding for school supplies and sports equipment for the three area schools; Khamsavang, Sebanghien and Pouthampoung K-5th Grade Schools in the Songkhone Savannakhet School District.

We would be providing school supplies of pens, pencils, erasers, notebooks, rulers, pencil sharpeners, chalk and sports equipment for three school comprising of approximately 950 students. This is a highlight of the trip where each student gets something they can personally benefit from in addition to the personal, individual interaction with the Falang (not the Thai Farang or foreigner) that occurs during distribution.

Recommendation: That TLCB approve this request for \$1,350

In addition to the above, on the team are three Doctors who will be doing chiropractic care, wellness education and other general healthcare treatment. We also will be building a well at least one of the schools and possibly two. Neither of these is funded by TLCB, however, it is a partnership that without TLCB's participation, it wouldn't necessarily be happening nor would it be as big as an impact.
