Proposed:

Request for funds to buy materials for the repair of Ban Sy Sieng Mai Primary School, M. Paek, Xieng Khouang Province.

Ref: Request by the Sy Sieng Mai community to repair the Primary school building. The Ban Sy Sieng Mai 5-Grade Primary School is located some 32 km. west of Phon Savanh and has been in use for 26 years. It was built in 1992 by the residents, who are Hmong and who returned to Laos from Thailand in 1990. It is of permanent construction measuring 8 x 42 m. (including the corridor.) with a tin roof and brick walls. Funding was provided by the UNHCR.

At present, the school community consists of 162 homes with 79 Hmong families: 83 Lao Loum families and no Lao Theung families. The school has 10 teachers of whom one is a woman and 146 students of whom 91 are girls. Of the students, 62 are Lao Loum and 84 are Hmong. There are no Khamu students.

The school's tin roofing has rusted through and leaking. The ceiling panels have all deteriorated and are discolored from rain and rot.

The school leadership has approached the Muang and Province Education offices to assist in requesting funds from the TLCB. Families already contribute what they can to community requirements and given that they are primarily subsistence farmers, they have no other means of livelihood to support rehabilitation of the school. What they can do is contribute the labor to get the work done if materials can be provided. Thus the community hopes that the TLCB could help with funding for materials needed.

Request for funds to buy materials for the repair of Ban Chom Sy Primary School, M. Phou Kout, Xieng Khouang Province

Request by the School Principal and the Headman of B. Chom Sy submitted to the Province Office of Education and Sports for funds to repair the old and dilapidated Primary school.

The 5-Grade Chom Sy Primary School in M. Phou Kout, is located some 59 km. from Phon Savanh, off of the Phon Savanh-Vientiane road, Rt. 7. The school was built in 1997 of semi-permanent construction measuring 8 x 35 m. (including the corridor), with tin roofing, board walls and without flooring.

The school serves 4 communities of 138 families with 800 inhabitants of whom 397 are women. There are 346 Hmong. There are no Khamu families. The school has 8 teachers of whom 4 are women. There are 80 students of whom 42 are girls. There are 49 Hmong of whom 29 are girls and 31 Lao Loum of whom 13 are girls.

The condition of the school is as follows: the tin roof is rusted out and leaking. As the floor is dirt not cement, it turns to mud in the rainy season. The limited funding raised by the people is not used for repairs since most of it goes to providing teachers and students with necessary supplies for teaching and learning during the school year.

Thus, the community has made this request for funding for repairs from the TLCB by first going to the Muang and Province offices. The community stands ready to provide all the labor needed to make repairs. The community hopes for consideration of this request from the TLCB.
