Motion 18-20 Laos Quality of Life Program

Estimated Amount = \$3,679

Proposed:

Request funds to buy materials for repair and rehab of Ban Lang Chong Primary School, M. Phou Kout, Xieng Khouang Province which includes support to aid a nearby school damaged by storms.

Documents were submitted by the school and Phou Kout District Education Office to the Xieng Khouang Education and Sports Office. The funds are for materials to help make repairs at the school and build dorms for students and teachers who will come from Ban Sop Sam School which was severely damaged by the recent natural disaster due to high winds.

The Ban Lang Chong Primary School in M. Phou Kout is located some 94 Km northwest of Phon Savanh town and borders Muang Phon Xay of Luang Phabang Province. This school serves ethnic minorities, especially, Khamu, in a region surrounded by high mountains. Every year mountain streams in the valleys will often flood the rice fields and gardens and even the dwelling places of the people.

At present, the Ban Lang Chong Primary School has one building of permanent construction and one of semi-permanent construction. To address the need to provide for students and teachers from the neighboring community that suffered damage in the wind storm, the school's main needs are to :

- build two dorm buildings for girls and boys. Each building would measure 7 x 14 m., including a corridor.
- lay cement floors in the existing kindergarten room measuring 8 x 21 m. including the corridor.

The 2 dorms to be built will mainly accommodate the students and teachers from the Sob Sam community school demolished by the wind storm. For this, Lang Chong community members will use old wood and cut new wood for the 2 dorm structures. The community is also canvassing for help to obtain other necessary building materials.

At present this school serves 3 areas having 186 families with 930 inhabitants of whom 83 families are Lao Loum, and 103 families are Khamu. There are no Hmong. There are 12 teachers of whom 4 are women with 124 students of whom 58 are girls. The majority of the students are Khamu.

Faced with this situation, the school has met with the Phou Kout District Education authorities and the Xieng Khouang Province Education and Sports Office for help in requesting aid from the TLCB assistance committee to respond to the damaged neighboring school. If material aid is given, labor would be the responsibility of the community. We hope the TLCB would kindly consider this request.
