

## Memory Quilt

Rosie's Raffle will take on a different tone this year. As a group, we want to celebrate the late Rosie Wheatley's past work and honor the nature of her efforts to contribute so much to the success of the TLCB Assistance program. Rosie was the above-and-beyond, paramount fundraiser through the years. It is to her memory that this year's quilt symbolizes a kind of raffle renaissance.

In 2005, John and Maty Pierre-Benoist won the quilt raffle. A member was very disappointed at not obtaining the quilt since it had very special meaning to him. He contacted Maty and John to see if they were interested in selling it, and they graciously agreed to relinquish ownership since the new owner promised to provide a generous donation to the Assistance program.

We have included a sheet of raffle tickets with each copy of the June Mekong Express Mail newsletter. Tickets are \$2 each.
